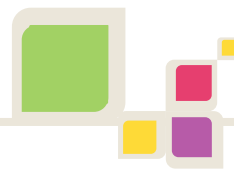


Ms Gwendolyn Lau, Executive Director of Tax Advisory & Compliance

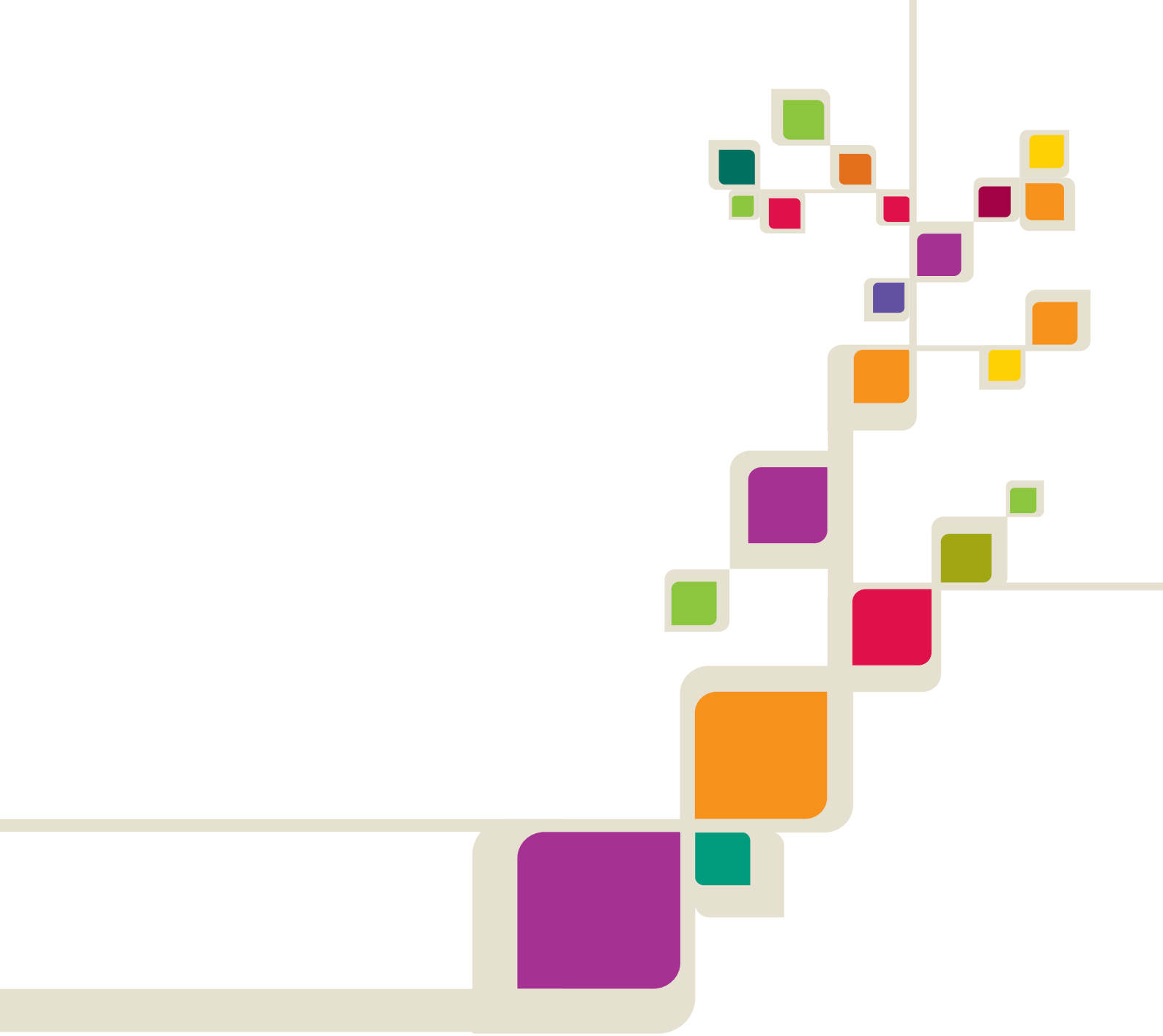
